### OVERVIEW & DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES

The Whistler Museum focuses on preserving and interpreting history, nature & mountain culture. During July and August, the museum runs a Discover Nature drop-in program at Lost Lake under a tent. The main role of Discover Nature Interpreters is to help connect park users with nature to ultimately encourage stewardship. During the western toad migration, which typically happens around the end of July/beginning of August, our effort will focus on the toads.

We will be hiring both full and part time positions. These positions are great opportunities for anyone interested in learning more about Whistler’s amazing nature while gaining experience in interpretation & leadership. Training will be provided.

We will be following all Covid requirements as recommended by the province and RMOW and keeping on top of the ever-changing situation.
